After three years of falling at the last hurdle, Norway's Thomas Ulsrud finally took European gold when he beat Denmark's Rasmus Stjerne by 5-3 at the Le Gruyere European Curling Championships in Champéry, Switzerland.

In the women's section Sweden's Stina Viktorsson beat Scotland's Eve Muirhead by 8-6 in a high-class final to take gold and her first European crown.

Host nation Switzerland landed a bronze double when Mirjam Ott led their women's team to a 9-5 win over Russia's Ludmila Privivkova, and Christof Schwaller was a 7-4 winner over Germany's Andy Kapp.
